I've recommended before to some of you Henry Glassie's monumental Passing the Time in Ballymenone, certainly among the two or three books that have my highest respect as a student of Irish folklore, and without equal in my experience as an in situ study of contemporary Irish culture, in this case in County Fermanagh in the 1970s.

After looking again this evening at the masterful first chapter of the book (which focuses on storytelling and ceili customs), I decided to Google his name. Here are two of the pieces that came up: one with two short audio archive pieces from his time in Ballymenone -- one on mummering, the other a song: and an Irish Examiner article with a short video clip from a documentary on his work.
